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Organizational Structure

The Partnership is a nonprofit organization with 501 (c) (3) status. It is representative of the broader community and has a unique Board of Director structure that enables balanced decision-making.

- 5 Directors from the business sector, consumers or ratepayers

Directors are elected by representative members from each caucus. The Board sets policy and makes decisions based on information provided by the organization's staff and a Technical Advisory Group (TAG).
